PRIVACY STATEMENT

Information we collect

Our school collects and records personal information, including sensitive information about students and parents or guardians, before and during the course of a student's enrolment at our school. Laws governing or relating to the operation of schools require that certain information is collected. These may include Public Health and Child Protection laws. We may ask you to provide medical reports about students from time to time. Health information about students is sensitive information within the terms of the National Privacy Principles under the Privacy Act.

Purpose of collection

The primary purpose of collecting and recording this information is to enable the provision of quality Catholic education. In addition, some of the information we collect and record is to satisfy the school's legal obligations, particularly to enable the school to discharge its duty of care to students and parents/guardians. This information may also be used for appropriate parish purposes.

Disclosure of information

This information may be disclosed by us for administrative and educational purposes to others including, but not limited to, personnel within Brisbane Catholic Education Centre, other systemic schools, medical practitioners, people providing services to schools, such as specialist visiting teachers and consultants.

Personal information collected from students is regularly disclosed to their parents or guardians. On occasions, information such as academic and sporting achievements, student activities, and other news may be published in newsletters, magazines, and on our website. Parents may seek access to personal information collected about them and their son/daughter by contacting the school.

Students may also seek access to personal information about them. However, there will be occasions when access is denied. Such occasions would include where access would have an unreasonable impact on the privacy of others, where access may result in a breach of the school's duty of care to the student, or where students have provided information in confidence.

The school from time to time engages in fundraising activities. Information received from you may be used to make an appeal to you. It may also be disclosed to organisations that assist in the school's fundraising activities solely for that purpose. We will not disclose your personal information to third parties for their own marketing purposes without your consent.

We may include your contact details in a class list and school directory.

If you provide the school with the personal information of others, such as doctors or emergency contacts, we encourage you to inform them that you are disclosing that information to the school and why. They should also be informed that they can access that information if they wish and that the school does not usually disclose the information to third parties.

Our privacy position

Brisbane Catholic Education is bound by the *Privacy Amendment (Private Sector) Act 2000*, and has adopted the ten (10) National Privacy Principles. Professionals generally have degree or higher qualifications and experience in applying this knowledge to design, develop or operate complex systems; identify, treat and advise on problems; and teach others.

Business [management consultant, business analyst, accountant, auditor, policy analyst, actuary, valuer]

Group 4: Machine operators, hospitality staff, assistants, labourers and related workers

Drivers, mobile plant, production/processing machinery and other machinery operators.

Hospitality staff [hotel service supervisor, receptionist, waiter, bar attendant, kitchenhand, porter, housekeeper]

Office assistants, sales assistants and other assistants.

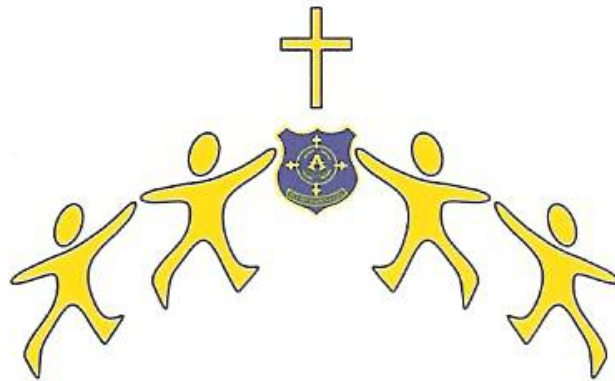
