## STRATEGIC RENEWAL FRAMEWORK 2012-2016

FOR CATHOLIC SCHOOLING - ARCHDIOCESE OF BRISBANE - The Strategic Renewal Framework details the Archdiocese's systematic approach to managing change and planning and implementing action in relation to Brisbane Catholic education priorities, strategic intents and local school priorities. The Strategic Renewal Framework is based on four priorities: Mission and Religious Education; Learning and Teaching; Professional Practice and Collaborative Relationships and Strategic Resourcing.

The annual goals that each school sets for the year ahead must be in alignment with and in the context of the Brisbane Catholic Education Centre's Strategic Renewal Framework. It is within this BCEC mandated framework that we are able to determine our goals for each year.

Please find included with today's newsletter two documents which are integral to setting the goals and strategic direction for us this year. The first document is the *Achievements Report 2013* which includes both the overarching goals for each of the priorities and also highlights ongoing actions. The second document is the *School Renewal Plan 2012-2016 Survey* inviting all members of the school community for their input and reflection on the four priorities of the Renewal Framework that are outlined above. Surveys are asked to be returned by Friday 14 February.

**SCHOOL BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT PLAN** - Each Brisbane Catholic Education school is responsible for implementing the Brisbane Catholic Behaviour Support Policy by developing a Whole School Student Behaviour Support Plan. The development of this plan is supported by BCE consultant. Various documents and aspects of school life, including School Mission Statement, School Profile, Beliefs About Learning and Behaviour, Consultation And Data Review, Roles, Rights & Responsibilities Of School Community Members, Student Behaviour Support and Behaviour Support for Individual Student Needs.

Last week all students were introduced to the four rules which underpin the School's Behaviour Support Plan. With their respective class teachers the students have established class and school expectations around these four rules.

- I Am Safe
- I Am Responsible
- I Am Respectful
- I Am A Learner

Included with this newsletter is draft of one part of this document – Behaviour Support in the Playground that teachers have introduced to the students this week.
